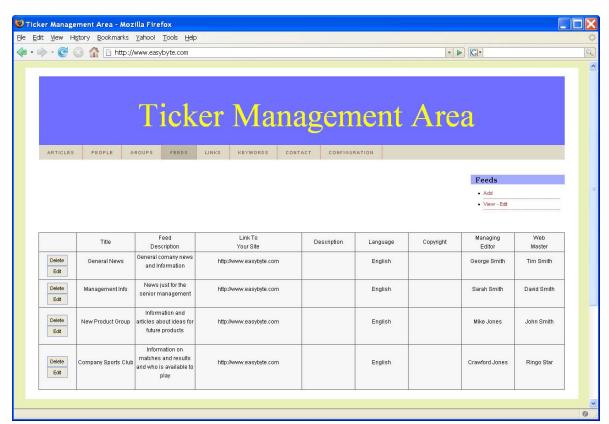


This consists of 2 pieces of software, the RSS Server and the desktop Ticker

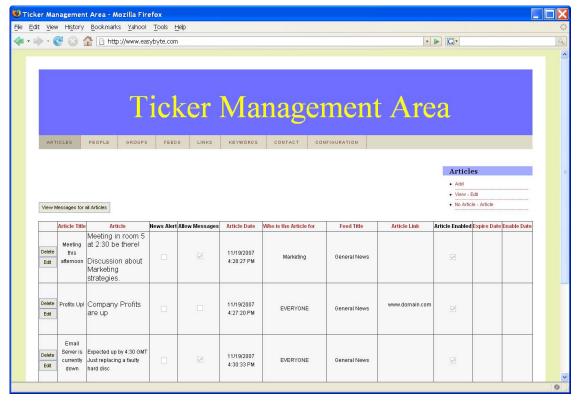
- No need for the user to run any application or load any web site, it's all automatic
 this means that it is actually used to it's full extent
- Runs hidden on users desktops until new information is available for them
- Information specifically for you and relevant to you comes to you
- System cannot be spammed
- Desktop Ticker is so easy to use, that the user does not even have to interact with it
- Works with all character sets
- Users can add comments to articles, which allows for a much more rapid creation of a corporate knowledge store
- Between 20-30% of emails today are either not read or are stopped by overeager spam filters, information sent via our system cannot disappear







- Easily create a Corporate Information Store, so that information is not hidden away in employees' inboxes
- Can use for notification broadcasting for certain groups of people or an entire distributed workforce
- Installs in 10 Mins
- Connects to an Active Directory for easy management
- EasyByte RSS Server is the only one that allows for 2-Way communication, allowing users to add comments onto Articles, is a great way of creating a corporate knowledge store



- RSS is an Open Standard allowing not just our Ticker to connect to it, but any RSS enabled application, on any system, including mobiles, such as iPhone or Blackberry

What is RSS?

Really Simple Syndication



RSS is an open, XML based format that can be used in different ways for content distribution

RSS distributed content is designed for ease of importing by software, so it can be used in a wide variety of applications, web sites and mobiles

Pretty much anything that can be broken down into discrete items can be syndicated via RSS. RSS is used for *persistent information* delivery

This means that EasyByte's Ticker System has many Typical Corporate usages:

- Allows Project Team members to keep everyone updated on key aspects of work
- Keep Distributed Workforces and home workers informed
- Helpdesk operators can be easily informed about common reasons for calls
- Send Notifications to some or all desktops
- Use as a suggestion area to get ideas from employees
- Eliminate the use of mass broadcast company emails, which clog up systems
- Let Sales Teams know about current promotions to push and what products are low on stock
- Sales Teams keep each other informed
- Create a **knowledge store** on 'stuff' that frequently happens and what to do when it does (faq)
- Reduce costs and times to get new employees up to speed
